

"Straight from the Hart EMC" Goat Show

1. The show is open to Georgia 4-H and FFA members.
2. All Georgia 4-H and FFA State Livestock Rules and Regulations will be followed. The only exception is there is NO limit to entries as well as allowing kindergarteners to show.
3. Only wethers and does allowed. NO BUCKS. All goats will be shown as market. Does and wethers will be shown separately.
4. Goats will be weighed and divided into classes as evenly as possible. After the goats leave the scales, there will be no re-weighs.
5. Classes: Exhibitors must show their own goat(s) in classes. If an exhibitor has more than one goat in a class, he/she can find an exhibitor substitute to show for him/her. The substitute exhibitor must be entered in the show as well. This must be cleared with show officials before showing.
6. Showmanship: Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal in showmanship. The animal must be entered in the show (weight class) and owned by the exhibitor. There will be a pee-wee class for any exhibitor under first grade (prizes awarded). Kindergarten exhibitors wanting to compete with 1st grade showmen should pay the \$5 showmanship fee (buckle). All others will be entered in pee-wee (no buckle).
7. All goats must be dehorned or have horns tipped.
8. All goats must be tagged with a scrapie tag.
9. Entry Fee: The entry per animal is \$25. The deadline is **July 28** at midnight (online). If entries don't make max, we will accept late entries the day of. If brought the day of the show, the entry fee will be \$40/animal CASH! Showmanship entry fee is \$5.00 per exhibitor. Money will be used for prizes and/or prize money after expenses are removed. The amount of prize money is based on entries. Showmanship will be broken down into 12 divisions (1 grade per class).
**Buckles will be awarded for showmanship class winners.

10. Pens will be preassigned per county according to entries. Showing off trailers will not be allowed.

11. A certificate of Veterinary Inspection is required with the individual identification and the following statement: Flock of origin is free from Foot Rot, Scabies, Contagious Ecthyma (soremouth), Cutaneous Fungal Lesions, Scrapie or any other Infectious disease. All Does must have a USDA approved scrapie tag in the ear. Registration numbers will not serve as the scrapie tag for the show.

12. The Hart County FFA Alumni & show committee reserves the right to review the rules and make changes if necessary. All decisions made by the Hart County FFA Alumni & show committee are final.

13. Absolutely no refunds will be given.

14. There are no weight limits.

15. The Ag Center will open at 6am Saturday morning and goat check-in/weigh-in will be 7am-8am. The show will start at 9am. Showmanship will be first (youngest to oldest) followed by weight classes. **Doe weight classes will show first, followed by wether weight classes.**

16. The Hart County FFA accepts no responsibility nor assumes any risk for injury to the exhibitor or animal due to or resulting from participation in the "Straight from the Hart EMC" Goat Show.

17. All exhibitors and adults in attendance of the event shall AT ALL TIMES conduct themselves with honesty and good sportsmanship. Violators will be prohibited from competing and will be asked to leave at the discretion of the alumni & show committee.

18. NO FRIDAY NIGHT CHECK-IN & NO OVERNIGHT STAY ON THE GROUNDS.
